By signing this form you are giving Kyogle Youth Action permission to take your young person's temperature upon entry into the Laneway Community Space.

If their temperature falls outside the normal range we will wait 10 minutes and then take a second reading. If their temperature is still high we will contact you directly to discuss. They will not be permitted entry into the space and we will isolate them from the other young people as a pre-caution.

By signing this form you also agree for us to hold onto your information and share it with NSW Health if in the unlikely event there is an incident of COVID-19 and contact tracing is required.

FAQ

Why are you taking my child's temperature?

Fever is a symptom of COVID-19. We are taking your young person's temperature as a pre-caution to help us keep all of our young people, workers and volunteers safe.

I have heard that you can have COVID and no temperature, so why are you still taking their temperature?

Taking their temperature is just one of the things we are doing to stay safe along with social distancing, extra cleaning and limiting the amount of people in the space. These all fall into line with current NSW government guidelines.

What will you do if my young person has a high temperature?

We will isolate them from the group and wait 10 minutes before taking another reading. If the second reading is high we will contact you directly. We will always be respectful about your child's wellbeing and emotional state during this time.

What if I don't want my young person's temperature taken?

That's your choice. We are a voluntary service and no-one is forcing you to allow us to do this, but if you would like your young person to access the Laneway Community Space then we require a temperature check.

Can I change my mind?

Yes. Just let us know and we will revoke your permission slip. Please be aware that your young people won't be able to access the centre once you have retracted permission for us to take their temperature.

So you are excluding me and my family from seeking help?

No. This is all about physical access to the centre. Even if you don't want us to check your young person's temperature we are still more than happy to help over the phone, via Zoom or in the park outside the Laneway Community Space. Regardless of your choice, no-one will be excluded from the service.

However, please be aware that we can only be responsible for young people under our direct supervision, therefore if your young person is not accessing the centre we cannot accept responsibility for their care, safety and wellbeing. This includes if they are using the park outside the centre.

What do you do with mine and my young person's information?

Very little. We will keep it on file if we need to contact you. We will also share it with NSW Health if they request it to assist with contact tracing. By filling out the permission slip you are agreeing to let us do that, and it is also a pre-requisite for entry into the centre.

I don't believe in COVID and I am angry that you are excluding my young people from the Laneway Community Space.

Again, we are not here to tell you what to think or feel. These pre-cautions are in line with the advice from NSW Health. Again, we are a voluntary service and will not force you or your young person to do something you are not comfortable with.
